The Masonic Foundation is a 501(c)3 private, non-profit organization.

The Masonic Foundation of the District of Columbia's scholarship is available to select graduates from DC public and charter high schools. The scholarship is \$7,500.00, must be applied towards tuition, and is renewable for a total of four years, providing that the student maintains and demonstrates a 3.0 GPA or better.
